TIPS FOR PRINTING & USE:

If possible, print on card stock and laminate or cover with clear contact paper for durability.

Ideas for use:

1. Cut out around the four playing boards and the 36 playing cards. You may want to trim off all sharp corners for safety and comfort.
2. For 2 to 4 players, give each child one playing board and hold up one playing card at a time. The player with that animal on their board should raise their hand and take the card, placing it on the matching square. The winner is the first to cover all nine squares.
3. For 1 player, give the child one or more playing boards and all or selected cards. Have them cover the squares with matching cards.
4. Cards can also be used for other games: Find all the farm animals, zoo animals, or animals colored gray, for example. Or make two copies of cards to make matched pairs.
