### TIPS FOR PRINTING & USE:

If possible, print on card stock and laminate or cover with clear contact paper for durability.

#### Ideas for use:

1. Cut out around all or selected cards, or leave as whole pages for bulletin board displays.
2. Show children one card at a time, asking them to guess the word and find its opposite.
3. Lay out all or selected pairs and have children make opposite word matches.
4. Shuffle about a dozen pair (24 cards) and place face-down in rows on a table. Flip over 2 cards at a time, trying to find matches. If no match is made, flip the cards back over and let the next player have a turn. If a match is made, remove the two cards and keep as a "winnings" pile. The player with the most cards in their pile wins that round.
